

# myBMP – best practice benefits the whole industry

The Cotton industry's *myBMP* program is one of the key planks behind cotton's reputation as an innovative and proactive Australian agricultural industry.

*myBMP* is the web-based best practice management system freely provided to all Australian cotton growers as a centralised location for access to important information, or to conduct a farm self-assessment against industry developed best practice standards. It provides tools to:

- Better manage business risk;
- Help improve on-farm production performance;
- Maximise potential market advantages; and,
- Demonstrate responsible and sustainable natural resource management.

As well as meeting future challenges early, *myBMP* supports continual industry improvement.

While most Australian cotton growers already meet the majority of industry best practice principles, grower participation in *myBMP* also helps deliver a powerful information-based platform which can help industry influence and achieve positive outcomes when working to protect important cotton industry farming rights.

After consultation with growers, researchers and industry bodies, in August 2010 *myBMP* was relaunched in a program that completely rejuvenated and extended the original BMP system.

The *myBMP* is fully supported by Cotton Australia, the Cotton Research Development Corporation and Cotton Seed Distributors through the CottonInfo joint venture, and is a cornerstone component in delivery of industry extension work.

Each year modules are reviewed to ensure they reflect recent research and provide industry with current best practice.
