

The Cotton Pest Management Guide contains the industry's **first** HRMS, which outlines the most effective way to delay resistance. **Find it on page 88.** 






## Part with your pests!

The insecticide resistance management strategy (IRMS) includes all activities commercially available for use in cotton targeting all pests. It should be consulted for every insecticide/miticide decision.

When used with the Impact on Beneficials table (page 8 of the Cotton Pest Management Guide), it allows growers to be pre-emptive and target pests without unnecessarily disrupting beneficials. **Find it on page 66.**
