
US/11: Conference travel grant to the 1992 Australian Cotton Conference

Funds for Mr. Stephen Kimber and Dr. I.R. Kennedy were provided by the CRDC for travel and accommodation to the Australian Cotton Conference held at Jupiter's Casino on the Gold Coast.

A joint paper was presented in the Conference Proceedings entitled "The fate of endosulfan sprayed on cotton for insect control".

Attendance at the conference was beneficial to both researchers. It provided an opportunity to meet with cotton farmers and to discuss their problems and concerns regarding the use of pesticides. Also, it allowed us to be exposed to other research programs being conducted on behalf of the CRDC and the cotton industry. This information is of value in planning our own work.
